Focus of the Week

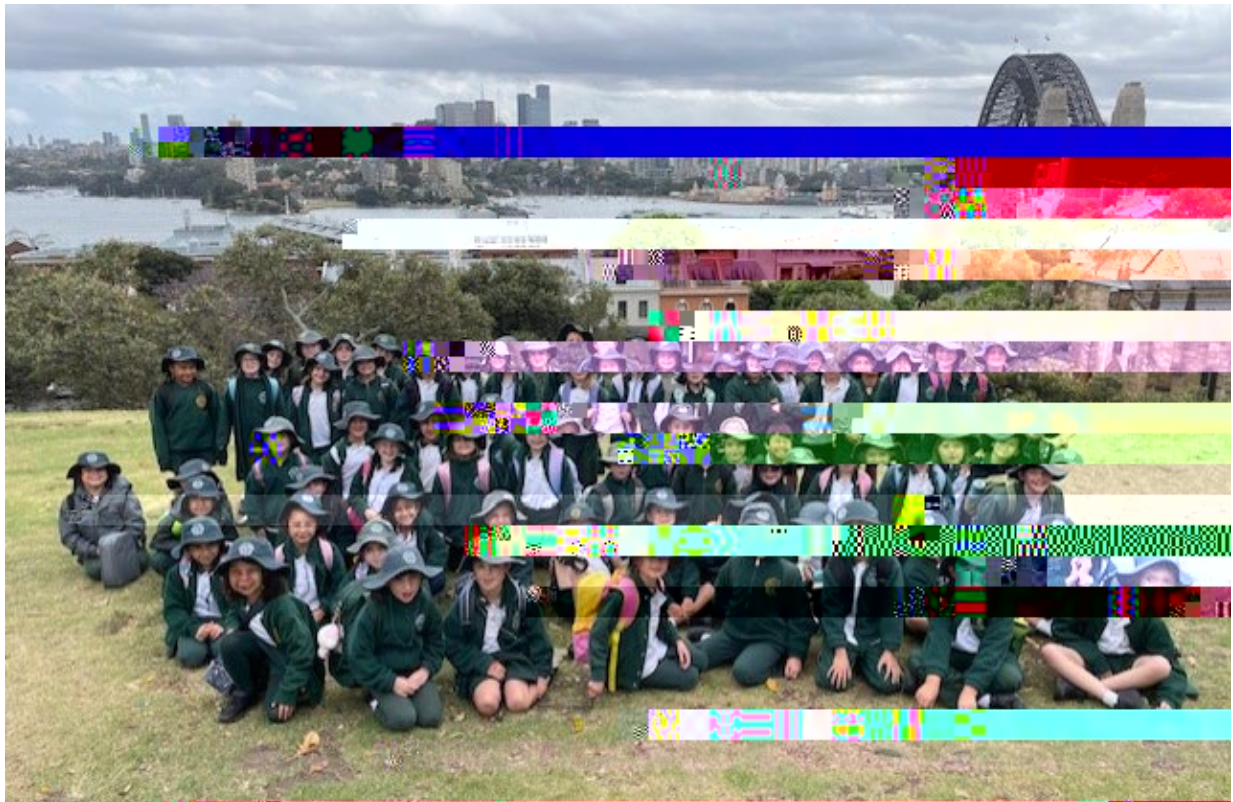

On Tuesday, students in Years 1 and 2 had a terrific time on their excursion to The Big Dig Archaeology Centre at The Rocks on Tuesday. We started and finished the day at Observatory Park overlooking Sydney Harbour imagining how it has changed over the last few hundred years.
